




Trips for the ICHME Conference on the afternoon of September 21st, 2022

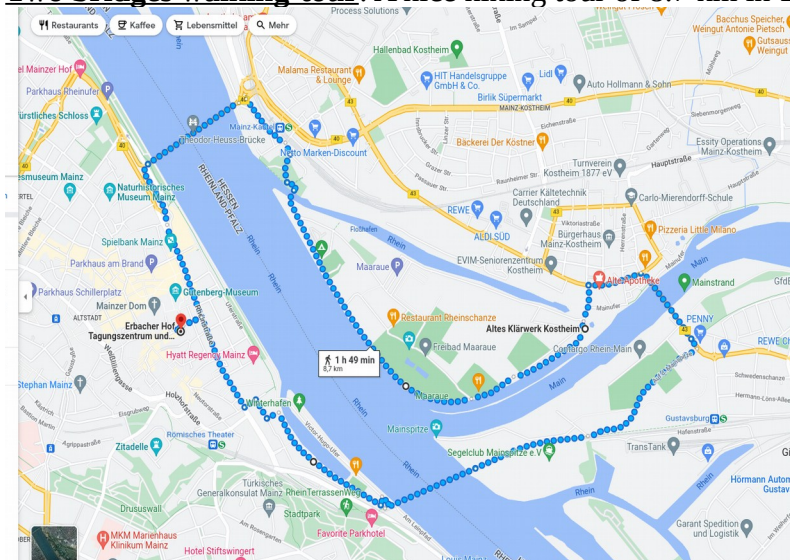
1. Per train, ferry to Rüdesheim and back to Mainz by the Köln-Düsseldorfer

Total price for tickets (without special reduction): 29,20 Euro.

- 2:03 p.m. Mainz Hbf  [RB 26 \(25428\)](#), Direction Köln Messe/Deutz, Gl. 2a – Arrival at Bingen(Rhein) Stadt at 2:31 p.m. Ticket at the ticket machine: 8 Euros (without reduction). (Earlier, there is already a train leaving at 1:03 p.m. from Mainz Hbf.)
- Walking 450 m to the embarkation point (Brücke 4) of the ferry.
- 3:00 p.m. Bingen(Rhein), Brücke 4, ferry  to Rüdesheim(Rhein) KD
Arrival at Rüdesheim(Rhein) at 3:15 p.m. Ticket price: 2,80 Euros to pay at the ferry.
- About one hour time in the (small) town of Rüdesheim
- At 4:20 p.m. the boat  (Köln-Düsseldorfer) leaves from Rüdesheim to Mainz and arrives there at 6:30 p.m. Ticket price: ticket G for 18,40 Euro. Moreover, there will be an extra reduction from 30 persons on.
- The KD boat has nice seating accommodation and catering.
- Creditcards (Master, Visa) and EC-Cards are accepted for the payment without extra fees.

4. Landesmuseum Mainz



Mainz State Museum is the museum of cultural history in Rhineland-Palatinate and can be found in the Grosse Bleiche right in the centre of Mainz. The baroque building in the converted electors' stables later became a 'Golden-Ross-Kaserne' with a modern glass and steel structure in the inner courtyard. Not only is it home to one of the most important collections on cultural history in the state of Rhineland-Palatinate, it also opens up for a range of cultural events outside of museum opening hours.

The collections showcase: Prehistory, Roman times, the Middle Ages, the Renaissance, the Baroque period, graphics from the 16th to the 20th century, Dutch painting, 18th-century porcelain, 19th-century painting, Judaica, city history, Art Nouveau glass and modern art. There are numerous temporary exhibitions on art, culture and history, including contemporary history, that complement the extensive collections.
